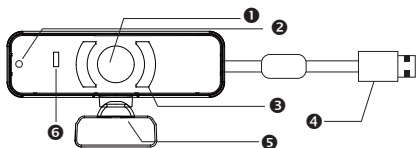

Quickstart Guide



Open the camera mount and orient the camera frontwards



Place the camera on top of your computer screen and move the mount until it is secure against the screen and the camera is facing you and tilted as needed



Connect the USB cable



Wait about 10 seconds, and then launch your video conference app, such as Zoom, Teams, Bluejeans, Skype, etc
