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
Thanks for purchasing the Blues Combo™ BT/USB Wireless Headset. Please read this guide to get maximum use of the headset and dock.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION


- Charge the battery to full before using it for the first time.
- Keep the headset dry and avoid damp locations to prevent damage to the internal circuitry.
- Keep the product away from direct sunlight and excessive heat. High temperatures shorten the life of electronic devices and the battery, and may warp certain plastic parts.
- Excessive cold may also damage the circuit board.
- Don't try to repair or disassemble the product: you may damage the product and void the warranty.
- Try not to drop it on hard surfaces to avoid damage to the internal circuitry.
- Avoid using harsh chemicals or cleaners.
- Even if you're not using the headset, please charge it to full at least 3 times a month to maintain battery life.

If your product isn't functioning properly, return it to the where you bought it, if it's within their return period. Otherwise, please review our return policy at the end of this guide.

Charging

Please charge before using

• 2 Options

1. **Base:** Use the USB Charging Cable to connect the Base to a charging source. The light on the front of the base will be on. Place the headset into the charging base, making sure the headset is aligned with the charging contacts. The headset's indicator light will be on.
2. **Cable:** Plug the **USB cable** into the headset and a charging source, computer or wall adapter. The headset's indicator light will be on.
 - While charging, the charging indicator will be solid Red. After being fully charged, the charging indicator light will be solid Blue.
 - The headset's indicator light will flash Red when the battery is low.

Power ON/OFF and Pairing

Power ON

- With the headset OFF, slide the headset power switch to the Middle position; the headset will power ON. If it has not been paired yet, the headset will automatically enter Pairing mode (Red/Blue flashes) when turned on. The headset will re-connect (Blue light flashes) with a previously paired device.

Power OFF

To power OFF, slide the headset power switch to the Right position.

Pairing

- With the headset ON but not in calling mode, slide the headset power switch to the Left position, and hold it for about 2 seconds, until the indicators alternately flash 'Red/Blue', and you hear "Pairing". Release the switch; the headset is now ready to pair with Bluetooth devices.
- Turn on Bluetooth on your mobile phone/laptop or other Bluetooth device. When the device finds 'BluesCombo' select it. Once paired, you will hear "Connected" and the indicator light will change from alternating red/blue flashing to a slow blue flash. NOTE: If asked for a code use 0000.
- Use your PC/Mac's sound icon to choose 'BluesCombo Stereo' for listening to music.
- When using as Softphone for meetings, such as Zoom or MS Teams, or using the mic and speakers, choose 'BluesCombo Hands Free Audio'.
- You can enter pairing mode any time by moving the Power Switch to the Left position.
- To reconnect to a previously paired device: With the headset OFF, slide the power switch to the Middle. You will enter reconnect mode, and the Blue LED will flash. The headset will start to search for devices previously connected.

- Once the headset connects with the remembered device, you will hear “Connected” through the headset and the Blue LED will change to a slow flash.

Answer/reject/hang up calls

First, pair the headset with your Bluetooth device.

Answer

- When call comes in, click the 'Answer/Reject Call/Siri' button on the headset to answer the call.

Reject

- To Reject an incoming call, press and hold the 'Answer/Reject Call/Siri' button on the headset for 1-2 seconds; the call will be rejected.

End a Call

To end the call, click the 'Answer/Reject Call/Siri' button on the headset.

Volume Adjustment

- Pair the headset with your Bluetooth device.
 - To increase the volume, click the 'Volume +' button on the headset.
 - To lower the volume, click the 'Volume -' button on the headset.

Play/Pause

- Pair the headset with your Bluetooth device.
 - While playing music, click the 'Play/Pause' button on the headset to pause it.
 - To resume, click the 'Play/Pause' button on the headset again.

Previous/Next

- Pair the headset with your Bluetooth device.
 - **Next:** While playing music, press and hold the headset's 'Volume +' button until the track goes to the next track, then release the button.
 - **Previous:** While playing music, press and hold the headset's 'Volume -' button until the previous track starts playing, then release the button.

Voice Assistant


- Pair the headset with your Bluetooth device.
 - While the headset is not in calling mode, quickly double-click the 'Answer/Reject Call/Siri' button of the headset, and the mobile phone will start the voice control function.

Mic Mute

- Pair the headset with your Bluetooth device.
 - While using the headset for talking or recording, click the 'Mic Mute' button on the headset. The microphone will mute, and the mute indicator will turn on.
 - While in mute status, click the 'Mic Mute' button on the headset, and the microphone will activate again, and the mute indicator will turn off.

Using the Dongle

- With the headset off, slide power switch to the Middle, and enter the reconnect mode. The Blue LED will flash, and the headset will start to search for devices connected before.
- Plug the Dongle (included in the package) into your PC/Mac computer's USB-A port.
- The Headset and the Dongle will pair automatically, and you will hear "Connected" through the headset.
- Make sure the Dongle is set as the playback and recording device in your computer's setting.
- Make sure the Dongle is set as default audio device for your Softphone calls such as Zoom, and MS Teams.



Dual Connection

Dongle and Bluetooth Device



- Connect to the Bluetooth device first, then connect to the USB Dongle. First, make sure the USB Dongle is not plugged in.
- While OFF, slide the headset's power switch to the Middle; headset turns on.
- Slide and hold power switch to the Left side, until the circle indicator on the headset flashes Blue/Red and you enter pairing mode. You will hear "Pairing" through the headset; release the power switch.
- Go to the Bluetooth menu on your Device. Search and click to connect BluesCombo on your Phone/PC/laptop's Bluetooth lists. The circle indicator changes to Blue and flashes once after connected. You will hear "Connected" through the headset.
- Now you can play music/make phone calls from your Bluetooth device to your headphone. (If asked for pin code, type 0000)
- Plug in the Dongle (included in package) into your laptop's USB-A port.
- The Dongle will connect to the headset automatically.
- The Dongle and your Bluetooth device are now connected to the headset.

Dual Connection

2 Bluetooth Devices

- While OFF, slide the power switch to the Middle; the headset turns on.
- Slide and hold power switch to the Left side, until the circle indicator flashes Blue/Red to enter pairing mode. You will hear "Pairing" through the headset; release the power switch.
- Go to the Bluetooth menu on your device. Search and click to connect BluesCombo on your Phone/PC/laptop Bluetooth lists. The circle indicator will flash Blue once after connection. You will hear "Connected" through the headset. Now you can play music/make phone calls from the first device to headphone. (If asked for pin code, type 0000).
- Slide and hold power switch to Left side, until the circle indicator flashes Blue/Red and you enter pairing mode. You will hear "Pairing" through the headset.
- Connect to the second device.
- You will hear "Connected"; two devices are now connected to the headset.
